<p>General Points of Eligibility</p>	<p>Archers are eligible for consideration provided they are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> An Archery GB member in good standing Have satisfied all eligibility under the rules of World Archery (WA) and subject to any changes it may introduce subsequent to the publication of this policy Available for selection of the stated event Hold a current full UK passport, valid for at least 6 months after return date of the event Have no medical or wellbeing conditions that preclude travel by air to defined venue Have met the required selection scores (see below) 										
<p>Milestone Event Performance Target/s</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> All team members achieving top 22 cut off to proceed through to the elimination rounds A team to make the cut 										
<p>Context and Purpose of Championship selection</p>	<p>Selection is made in line with competitive performance standards in the international arena.</p> <p>AGB will only select athletes who can demonstrate they can be competitive and/or contribute to our objectives of medal winning success and as such the selection scores are based on performance standards demonstrated at International tournaments of similar standing to this event.</p> <p>The Performance Director, will consider only athletes deemed to be competitive at this level, and may elect to take fewer than the maximum permitted athletes.</p>										
<p>Timetable</p>	<p>Selection Window: 1st June 2021 through to 31st May 2022 (First period 1st June to 31st December 2021, Second period 1st January to 31st May 2022)</p>										
<p>Selection</p>	<p>Score will be considered for selection when achieved at 24 target rounds shot to World Archery rules at:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a one-day tournament the first day of a two-day tournament the second day of a two-day tournament if the archer has not entered the round on day one. An archer who starts but does not complete the first day of a two-day tournament will be deemed to have shot on the first day. 										

Archers wishing to be considered for the NI & GB 3D Team for 2022 will be required to complete the below criteria:

Two score(s) of:

	Barebow	Compound	Instinctive	Longbow
Men	420	472	403	364
Women	347	440	278	283

One score must have been shot in the second period of the selection window – between 1st January 2022 and 31st May 2022.

Selectors will consider a maximum of ONE score from tournaments outside Great Britain and Northern Ireland, provided that these are shot at WA 24 3D events. For tournaments outside the United Kingdom, it is the responsibility of the individual archer to supply an official result sheet to the selectors. Scores shot outside the United Kingdom after 2nd May 2022 will not be considered for selection.

Archers involved in Great Britain Target Teams during 2022 may be considered without the minimum number of scores, provided they can demonstrate their commitment to 3D archery and show good reason why they are unable to provide the required number of qualification scores.

In the event of no archers achieving the qualifying standard in a particular discipline or division, the selectors may offer a place to the highest placed archer in that discipline in order to ensure team representation. This will be at the discretion of the selectors, based on the scores shot during the qualifying period.

If at the end of the selection period two or more athletes are tied for 3rd place the selectors will use the following to decide the final team selection.

- The result of the 2022 British 3D Championships
- Scores from the 2020/2021 qualification period
- Past international results and medals won

If the selection period is disrupted further because of Covid 19 and not enough athletes complete the selection criteria and the event does run, the Performance Director working with the Compound Programme Manager and 3D Team Manager will put together a panel of 3D archery experts to select the team for the event.

Archers selected for the team will be notified by AGB Performance in the week following the selection meeting.

Nominated Courses

The Nominated events for the qualifying period are required to meet the following criteria
1-day 24 target 3D rounds

The tournament is run to WA requirements with official Archery GB Judges ensuring compliance to the rules.

Nomination and Selection Panel

Following the conclusion of the selection process, a selection panel will be convened to confirm selections for the event. The Panel will consider only athletes deemed to be competitive at this level, and may elect to take fewer than the maximum permitted athletes for these events.

	<p>The representatives at this meeting will be made up of the following;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Performance Director (Chair) • Compound Programme Manager • Field Team Manager (as appropriate) • Performance Archery Staff (as appropriate) • Performance Co-ordinator (Meeting notes) <p>In selecting a team that is in keeping with the context and aims of event selection in section 3, the panel will consider all available information, including, but not limited to athletes who have been unable to train or compete due to injury / illness or any other unforeseen circumstances, maintenance of form and fitness, performance readiness, performance potential, medal target, performance pedigree (including international medals won), injury/illness history, behavior and contribution to a team ethos.</p>
The 'Team'	<p>The 'Team' means the team which is selected by Archery GB which includes athletes, coaches, nominated reserves, medical support personnel, team leaders and any associated members of the World Class Programme team.</p>
Appeals	<p>Appeals against process must be submitted to the Performance Office within 7 days of selection being published. Appeals will be conducted according to the details on the Archery GB website.</p>
Following the conclusion of the selection process.	<p>Once athletes and other Team members have been advised of their selection by the Performance Director, they (including any reserve(s)) must agree not to withhold any information on availability, fitness, injury status or illness that could affect their training or competitiveness at any time until the conclusion of the event;</p> <p>All selected athletes must declare any medications they are taking, in particular the use of any restricted medications and that they hold a valid Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) which can be produced when required by the relevant authority;</p> <p>An athlete and other Team members will be required to sign up to the relevant Code of Conduct or Athlete Agreement and any breach of this may result in disciplinary action including removal from the team and possible early return home from an event. In this case, any member sent home will be invoiced for the full cost of their entry into the event and any additional cost incurred in sending them home.</p> <p>Decisions on these matters are open to appeal as allowed by the relevant Archery GB Disciplinary process effective at the time of the incident.</p> <p>Athletes and other Team members selected, are required to attend all related training camps and competitions as laid out by the Performance Director and Events & Facilities Manager, from the selection announcement onwards.</p> <p>Athletes and other Team members will be expected to demonstrate they can actively contribute to the team unity required to be a successful international team.</p>
Funding Criteria	<p>Team members will need to self-fund. An outline of cost will be provided once details of the championship are known.</p> <p>Wherever possible the team management that are supporting the event will be funded by Archery GB.</p>

<p>Team Events</p>	<p>Where Team competitions are scheduled into the event, the selection of the competitors in the relevant team event such as Men’s Team, Women’s Team will usually consist of 1 archer from the following styles - Compound, Barebow or Instinctive and Longbow.</p> <p>Mixed Teams will consist of one male and one female from each bow style.</p> <p>The selection of the team event competitors is made from the results from the qualification rounds, standard procedure will be to select the archers that recorded the highest scores in the qualification rounds. However, the Team Manager may use their discretion to change the composition of a team if deemed necessary.</p>
<p>Announcement</p>	<p>Selected team members must agree not to make any announcement to the media or public in any form (including on any social or other media) regarding their selection until after Archery GB have announced the selection on the Archery GB web site www.archerygb.org</p>
<p>Any matters not covered by this Policy</p>	<p>Any matters arising from the selection processes, which are not covered within this policy, shall be determined by the Performance Director (or representative thereof) acting at their sole discretion.</p>
